Prompts	Question	Answer
Authenticity of the materials	Do the learning materials provide the pupils with authentic language input, are they exposed to real world content? (For example, materials such as news articles, videos, scientific, or interviews, the pupils are exposed to language as it is used in authentic contexts)	
Motivation and interest	Are the materials relevant and engaging for the pupils?	
Critical thinking and problem solving	Do the materials present authentic problems and challenges, related to the subject matter?	
Content integration	Do the learning materials allow for the integration of subject content and language learning?	
Transferability	by practising with real materials do the pupils acquire language skills that can be transferred to real-life contexts outside the classroom?
